January 6, 2011

From Portland: Follow SR67 South to the Muncie Bypass (SR3 & US35). Continue south to the first traffic light (McGalliard Road). Turn RIGHT on McGalliard Road (SR332) and follow to the Muncie Mall.

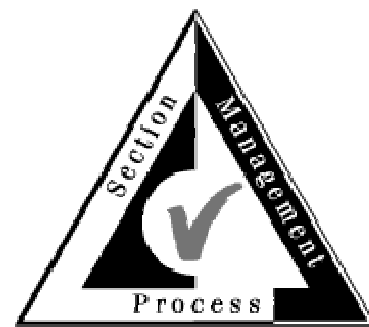
